Specifically, service dogs work for individuals with disabilities other than blindness or deafness. Service dogs are trained to perform a wide variety of tasks including but not limited to;

- Pulling a wheelchair
- Bracing,(balance and support)
- Retrieving
- Alerting to medical crisis and providing assistance in medical crisis
- Supporting individuals to help calm down, refocus and give a sense of comfort
